

ORDINANCE NO. 22 -82

An Ordinance to authorize the leasing of a new photocopy machine for the use of the City of Bexley and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Bexley is presently leasing a Xerox 3400 photocopy machine at the rate of \$400.00 per month, which is located in the Mayor's Office but used extensively by all departments of the City.

Section 2: That it is necessary to reduce the annual expenditure of funds in all departments of the City and that a significant cost reduction could be accomplished by replacing the present equipment with a Savin System 600, with collator, which equipment would meet the needs of all departments of the City government.

Section 3: That, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a lease agreement for the equipment required, the total cost of which shall not exceed the amount of \$250.00 per month plus a security deposit of \$259.20 and an installation charge of \$125.00 provided, however, that the Gordon Flesch Company, Inc., will pay all liquidated damage charges for the cancellation of the present Xerox equipment.

Section 4: That the Council of the City has, by Ordinance No. 1-82, appropriated funds to pay for the present lease, which funds shall be applied to the new agreement.

Section 5: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
