

ORDINANCE NO. 23 -82

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay the Columbus Dispatch for Legal Advertising for Bidding of Remodeling and Addition to Police Headquarters.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FO THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$1,300.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the \$650.00 Legal Advertising expense encured for the initial remodeling bids and an additional \$650.00 for Legal Advertising in anticipation of bidding on remodeling specifications currently being formulated.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
