

ORDINANCE NO. 24 -E-

An Ordinance to appropriate funds for the Auditor's Office for Miscellaneous Expenses for the remaining months of 1982.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$3,000.00 or more had been appropriated to the Auditor's Miscellaneous Account for over three (3) years.

Section 2: That the Auditor has used funds appropriated to this account wisely and efficiently over these years.

Section 3: That the sum of \$1,000.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to be used to pay operating costs of the Auditor's Office.

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be inforce, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
