

ORDINANCE NO. 25-82

To terminate the classification of College Avenue as a through highway and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: Section 4511.65 of the Ohio Revised Code defines a through highway in such a manner that College Avenue is at the present time a through highway and that said Code Section permits a municipal corporation by ordinance, to designate residential streets not a through highway.

Section 2: That in accordance with the provisions of Section 4511.65 of the Ohio Revised Code, College Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street, is hereby designated not to be a through highway.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that this ordinance will allow the City to reduce the posted speed limit on College Avenue, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
