

ORDINANCE NO. 57-82

An ordinance to appropriate funds for capital improvements for the 1982 fiscal year.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$51,300 be transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund and set aside and appropriated from that Fund to be used for the resurfacing and blacktop overlay of the following streets:

Commonwealth Park S.	Parkview	Columbia
Charles Street	Chelsea	Sheridan
Powell Avenue	Westland	Cassady
Dale Avenue	Cassady	Cassingham

Section 2. That the sum of \$3,000 be transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Garage Capital Improvements Account, No. 175, and appropriated and set aside in that account for the purpose of purchasing a steam cleaner for the Municipal Garage.

Section 3. That the sum of \$3,000 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing two (2) sets of mechanic tools for the Municipal Garage.

Section 4. That the sum of \$7,400 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing one (1) new pickup truck in the Service Department.

Section 5. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of the necessary equipment, materials, and labor, specifically identified in the four (4) previous sections, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sums so specified and appropriated in each section, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 6. Said contracts shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law, where bidding is required by law.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
