

ORDINANCE NO. 29 -82

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay for current Auditor-Treasurer fees as charged by the Franklin County Auditor's office on the Statement of Semi-annual Apportionment of Taxes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That an additional sum of \$6,000.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to be used to pay for the cost of Auditor and Treasurer fees as deducted by the Franklin County Auditor on the statement of apportionment of taxes.

Section 2: That pursuant to Ordinance No. 1-82 deductions for Auditor-Treasurer fees are greater to date than appropriated by said ordinance.

Section 3: That the additional sum is necessary to alleviate current obligations and projected Auditor-Treasurer deductions anticipated from the Franklin County Auditor and charged to the City of Bexley.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
