

ORDINANCE NO. 34-82

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to amend the contract with Noble's, Inc., which provides tow truck and storage services for impounded vehicles, by increasing the towing charges from \$25.00 to \$30.00, and the storage charges from \$3.00 to \$4.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority of Ordinance No. 40-81, the City of Bexley entered into a contract dated January 12, 1982, with Noble's, Inc., to assist the Bexley Police Department by providing tow truck and storage services for impounded vehicles;

Section 2. Said contract was for a period of three (3) years, but pursuant to its terms, may be terminated by either party by giving 30 days notice to the other;

Section 3. That Noble's, Inc., has now indicated a desire to amend said contract by increasing the towing fee, set forth in Section VI (A) from Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) to Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) and by increasing the storage charges, set forth in section VI (B) from Three Dollars (\$3.00) to Four Dollars (\$4.00), which amendments are hereby approved by this Council.

Section 4. That the Mayor and the Auditor should be, and hereby are, authorized and empowered to amend said contract as set forth above in Section 3 by increasing both the towing fee and the storage charge to be paid to Noble's, Inc., for its services for the City of Bexley;

Section 5. That the empounding and storage fees assessed and collected by the Bexley Police Department or by the City be increased accordingly which money is to be paid into the General Fund;

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall go into effect as provided by law from and after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
