

ORDINANCE NO. 36-82

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$952.00 for the cancellation charges on the Xerox 3400 Photocopy Machine and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City, at its option, cancelled the rental agreement on the Xerox 3400 Photocopy Machine and as part of this rental agreement incurred cancellation charges of \$952.00. Although the Gordon Flesch Company, Inc., has paid the liquidated damage charges to the City, said funds were deposited in the General Fund as required by law.

Section 2: That, therefore, the sum of \$952.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of said cancellation charges.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
