

ORDINANCE NO. 42-82

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$425.00 for programming tax changes and to authorize the expenditure.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That due to legislation by State and Federal Governing Authorities, Income Tax Withholding rates were changed July 1, 1982.

Section 2. That to comply with the legislation enacted by these Governmental Agencies it was necessary to retain Michael J. Zettler and Associates to provide the necessary programming changes.

Section 3. That the sum of \$425.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the programming of tax schedules by Michael J. Zettler and Associates.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
