

ORDINANCE NO. 48 - 82

An Ordinance to increase the salary of the Mayor of the City of Bexley effective as of the term of office commencing January 1, 1984 or thereafter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Bexley has reviewed the salaries of the chief executive officers of other central Ohio communities and has determined that the salary for the office of Mayor of the City of Bexley is substantially below the average and should be increased to correspond to others salary figures.

Section 2. That Section 5 of Article II, of the Charter of The City of Bexley authorized council by ordinance, to increase the salary for the office of Mayor, provided that such ordinance is passed not less than one year prior to the term to be thereby affected.

Section 3. That the present term of office for the Mayor expires as of the end of the year 1983 and that the new term of office commences as of January 1, 1984.

Section 4. That the salary for the office of Mayor of the City of Bexley should be and it is hereby increased to the amount of \$30,000 for the year commencing January 1, 1984, to \$32,000 for the year commencing January 1, 1985, to \$34,000 for the year commencing January 1, 1986, and to \$35,000 for the year commencing January 1, 1987, and that any and all other previous ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby superceded.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
