

ORDINANCE NO. 56-82

An Ordinance to appropriate funds for the purpose of conducting a rodent control program in the immediate area around Ferndale Place and Alum Creek.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,695.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of contracting with Torco Pest Control Company to conduct a rodent control program in the area bounded by Livingston Avenue on the south, Schneider Park on the north, Ferndale Place on the east and Alum Creek on the west.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
