

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 57-82

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Accepted Standards Home Inspections Company and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City of Bexley, Ohio, secure the services of State Certified Plumbing Inspectors to comply with Section 4101:2-1-45 (f) of the Ohio Basic Building Code, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Accepted Standards Home Inspections Company Personnel can and are willing to provide the necessary inspection services on a contractual basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Accepted Standards Home Inspections Company to provide plumbing inspections for the City of Bexley, Ohio.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, said emergency being that the contract agreement is necessary to go into effect on January 1, 1983, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
