

ORDINANCE NO. 59 -82

An Ordinance to establish the Police Station Building Fund and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Bexley to proceed with the remodeling of the police station and jail facility in the present fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, The City has twice solicited bids for such remodeling and construction, and has now accepted the lowest and best bid which conformed to the revised and amended plans and specifications prepared by the architects employed by the City; and

WHEREAS, this construction is now in progress and it is desirable for accountability purposes to establish a separate capital improvements fund and to pay all costs and expenses incurred in said project from such separate fund; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That pursuant to the authority of Section 5705.12, Revised Code of Ohio, and of the Charter of the City of Bexley, there is hereby created a special capital improvement fund to be known as the Police Station Building Fund which fund shall be used to pay all costs and expenses of the current remodeling and addition to the police station and jail facility, authorized by Ordinance No. 33-82.

Section 2. That the money to be expended from such fund shall be provided from time to time by appropriations from the General Fund, by transfers pursuant to law from other capital improvement funds maintained by the City of Bexley, which are no longer needed, and in any other manner permitted by law and as authorized by this Council.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
