

ORDINANCE NO. 60 -82

An Ordinance to fund the cost of the police station remodeling project by transferring the sum of \$215,000.00 from the Bond Retirement Fund to the Police Station Building Fund and by appropriating and transferring additional funds from the unencumbered General Fund to the Police Station Building Fund.

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley has for many years maintained a separate fund called the "Bond Retirement Fund", which fund was, in fact, for the capital improvement of the alleys of the City of Bexley and contained the unexpended balance of monies no longer needed for the purpose for which such fund was created, and

WHEREAS, the City has now created a capital improvement fund for the construction and remodeling of the police station and jail facility identified as the Police Station Building Fund, and

WHEREAS, the anticipated cost of the police station project will exceed the capital improvement funds otherwise available, and it will be necessary, in addition, to appropriate funds from the unencumbered General Fund, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$215,000.00 in the Bond Retirement Fund, which money represents the unexpended balance of funds used to pay for the construction and improvement of the alleys of the City of Bexley and is no longer needed for such purpose, be, and it hereby is, transferred to the Police Station Building Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$93,694.00 be and it is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the Police Station Building Fund.

Section 3. That the sum of \$308,694.00 be appropriated and set aside from the Police Station Building Fund and allocated to the following accounts within such fund as follows:

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
