

ORDINANCE NO. 63-82

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to reimburse a property owner for washing machine repairs caused by a disturbance in the main water line.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That in the course of repairing a fire hydrant near 907 Euclaire Avenue, debris in the form of mineral deposits was disturbed and agitated in the main water line causing it to enter the house service line of 907 Euclaire Avenue where it lodged in the valve of the washing machine, the property owner, Mrs. Sharon McAllister, was notified and advised to call a private appliance repair service to have the obstruction cleared from the valve;

Section 2: That such service was successfully performed by the Beechwold Appliance Parts & Service Company on October 28, 1982;

Section 3: That the amount of \$59.02 was billed to Mrs. McAllister for the repair service of the Beechwold Appliance Parts & Service Company and paid by her and that she should be reimbursed for this expenditure by the City;

Section 4: That the sum of \$59.02 should be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the Water Fund and the Auditor is hereby authorized to pay that amount to the property owner;

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
