

ORDINANCE NO. 66-82

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to accept Change Order No. 2, on the Bexley Police Headquarters Building Project and to appropriate funds and declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, during the course of construction on the Police Headquarters Building Project it was found certain items necessary for the proper completion of said project need to be changed from the original specifications and plans, and

WHEREAS, said items have been identified as items 1 through 9 on Change Order No. 2, submitted by the Contractor and approved by the Architect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to accept Change Order No. 2 from the Columbus Contractor Company for items identified as items 1 through 9, in the total amount of \$500.00.

Section 2. That the sum of \$500.00 be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to be used to pay the additional cost under the contract.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
