An Ordinance amending Ordinance 27-75, the granting of franchise to All-American Cablevision Company, and Ordinances 39-79, 47-80, and 3-82, all of which amended Ordinance 27-75 by granting prior increases and modifications in said company's rate structure, by increasing basic monthly charges for the first outlet, for Home Box Office. for Cinemax, and for The Tier Service.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That Ordinance 27-75 granted a non-exclusive franchise to All-American Cablevision Company to operate and maintain a community antenna television system within the City of Bexley, which franchise comes within the regulatory authority of said City particularly regarding the regulation of rates for the services provided;

Section 2. That by letter of December 28, 1982, the company has once again made a request for a rate increase on various of the services provided, and that pursuant to the required notice, a public hearing was held at City Council chambers on families, 1983;

Section 3. That after consideration of all information presented, the council found that the requests for rate increases were reasonable and justifiable under all the discumstances, and should be granted and that Section 24(b) of Ordinance 27-75 should be and it is hereby amended as follows:
