

ORDINANCE NO. 5 -83

To authorize the purchase of new police communications equipment and a logging recorder system for the police radio console and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into contracts with the lowest and best bidders for the purchase, delivery and installation of police communications equipment and a logging recorder system for the police radio console.

Section 2: That the amount of \$25,450.00 for police communications equipment and \$21,800.00 for logging recorder system has been appropriated and set aside from the General Fund in Ordinance No. 1-83, for the purchase of said equipment and that the contracts, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that this equipment is necessary for the operation of the Police Department, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
