

ORDINANCE NO. 6-83

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 6-81, as previously amended by Ordinance No. 8-82, regarding the charges for water and sewer usage in the City of Bexley and to set new rates.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That by Ordinance No. 6-81 this Council provided that the water and sewer rates to be charged to the residents of the City of Bexley will be established by Council upon the advice of the Water Department and dependent upon the needs of the City as determined by the costs to the City for the operation of the Water Department and the charges by the City of Columbus for the water and sewer usage;

Section 2: That the rates, as established by Ordinance 6-81, were then amended and modified by Ordinance 8-82 which was passed by Council on March 8, 1982;

Section 3: That the charges imposed by the City of Columbus to the City of Bexley have been substantially increased since the last amendment which necessitates further increase in the rates to be assessed to the residents for water and sewer usage;

Section 4: That the water rate charged by the City of Bexley on all bills issued after April 1, 1983, shall be \$9.60 per 1000 cubic feet (MCF);

Section 5: That the sewer rate charged by the City of Bexley on all bills issued after April 1, 1983, shall be \$13.15 per 1000 cubic feet (MCF);

Section 6: That Sections 4 and 5 of Ordinance 6-81, as amended by Ordinance 8-82, shall be and they are hereby amended accordingly;

Section 7: That this Ordinance shall be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
