

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 7-83

An Ordinance to amend Ordinances No. 2-75 and 14-81 by increasing the charges for garbage, refuse, leaves and grass collections in the City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That this Council established quarterly charges for refuse collection by Ordinance No. 2-75 and amended those charges by Ordinance No. 14-81, which adopted a scheduled incremental rate increase over a period of three (3) years.

Section 2: That the continued escalating costs of labor, equipment, and landfill charges since that amendment has necessitated a corresponding increase in charges to residents in order to cover the costs of the operation of the refuse collection by the City and to maintain the same high level of service to the residents.

Section 3: That Section 1(a) of Ordinance No. 2-75, as amended by Section 4 of Ordinance No. 14-81, is hereby amended to read ". . . a charge of \$84.00 per year, payable quarterly in advance, commencing April 1, 1983 . . ."

Section 4: That this Ordinance, and the consequent increase in refuse collection charges, shall not apply to those Senior Citizens who are occupants of Bexley residences, and maintain Bexley utility and refuse accounts in their own names for such residences, are 65 years of age or older, and make application for exemption from the effect of this Ordinance and the increased rates with the Bexley City Auditor.

Section 5: Those Senior Citizens, who meet all of the qualifying criteria set forth in Section 4, above, shall continue to be billed for refuse charges at the rates established by Section 1(a) of Ordinance No. 2-75, as amended by Section 4 of Ordinance No. 14-81.

Section 6: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and the increased rate shall be effective for the billing period commencing April 1, 1983.
