ORDINANCE NO. _ \$ -83

An Ordinance to appropriate funds for legal services on behalf of the City of Bexley and city officials as a result of litigation in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 234.03, Bexley Code, provides that the services of the City Solicitor in any litigated matters involving the City and/or city officials shall be established by Council and shall be in addition to the salary paid for services as attorney and counsel for the City of Bexley.

Section 2: That on March 10, 1982, the City of Bexley, the Mayor and the Auditor were sued in the Franklin County Common Pleas Court by various former members of the police department and that all such party-defendants were represented by the City Solicitor in said action;

Section 3: That the City Solicitor expended 18 hours of legal time from the filing of the suit until its dismissal on January 6, 1983, and that the agreed upon rate of compensation shall be \$60.00 per hour for such services.

Section 4: That the sum of \$1080.00 should be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to be paid to the City Solicitor upon presentation of his statement for legal services.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
