WHEREAS, the Franklin County Children Services Board has placed a 1.0 mill renewal levy on the November, 1983 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Children Services Board serves abused, neglected and homeless children who depend on the Agency as their only hope; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Children Services Board has demonstrated the need for this renewal levy because of an increasing demand for services, decreasing revenues, and increasing costs; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Children Services Board is required by law to provide certain services to children, whether or not there are funds available to pay for these services; and

WHEREAS, this levy will only meet the projected costs of maintaining current Franklin County Children Services Board's services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Bealey, Ohio, by endorsement passage of the 1.0 mill renewal levy, to support the continuing provision of services to abused, neglected and homeless children by the Franklin County Children Services Board, and to communicate this support to all citizens.
