

ORDINANCE NO. 11-83

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to accept bids for the purchase of a twenty-five cubic yard capacity refuse packer and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of a twenty-five cubic yard capacity refuse packer mounted on a diesel truck chassis, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum of \$45,000.00, appropriated in Ordinance No. 1-83, plus the trade-in of a 1978 GMC Packer Truck, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor;

Section 2: Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law;

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
