JOHN ROBERT moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, This Council in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a  
Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1st, 1984; and

WHEREAS, The Budget Commission of FRANKLIN County, Ohio, has  
certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor  
of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and  
what part within the ten mill tax limitation; therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Council of the City of Bexley, OHIO  
County, Ohio, that the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certifi-

- No. 1-84 Annual Appropriations Ordinance.

- " 3-84 To amend and clarify Ordinance No. 35-81 regarding the "consent" given by the City of Bexley to the Director of Transportation, State of Ohio, to replace the Clifton Avenue bridge, and the further agreements regarding the maintenance of the improvement upon completion of construction, the availability and maintenance of the right of way, the placing and maintaining of traffic control devices upon said improvement, and the obligations of the City of Bexley for arranging and rearranging all public or private utility lines or structures within the boundaries of the project; and to declare an emergency.
- " 4-84 To authorize work on the World War II monument at the Drexel Circle.
- " 5-84 To make appropriations for Capital Improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1984, to authorize capital purchases for said year, and to declare an emergency.
- " 6-84 Granting franchise to Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company to construct, maintain, and operate lines and appurtenances and appliances for conducting electricity in, over, under and through the streets, avenues, alleys and public places of the City of Bexley.
- " 7-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute a contract with Gregory S. Lashutka, City Attorney for Columbus, for the Prosecution of certain cases before the Franklin County Municipal Court, Criminal Division, and to represent the Bureau of Motor Vehicles in certain cases in Franklin County Municipal Court, Civil Division, and to confirm the appropriation of necessary funds.
- " 8-84 To purchase real property adjacent to City Hall to be used for off-street parking for municipal employees and the operation of the Municipal government and to declare an emergency.
- " 9-84 To authorize the City of Bexley to enter into an agreement with the City of Columbus to modify the previous contract between them of December 22, 1976 regarding the administration and collection of the Bexley City Income Tax, by eliminating the maintenance of a \$3,000.00 Trust Fund which was used to pay tax refunds and by paying such refunds directly from the Income Tax Trust Fund.
- " 10-84 To authorize the City Solicitor to render services to the City of Bexley in litigation matters in the Franklin County Courts and to authorize payments for such services.
- " 11-84 To authorize the City of Bexley to enter into a new contract with the Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company to be effective as of February 1, 1984 to provide electrical energy for traffic control equipment, to establish new rates and charges for such usage, to establish the manner and time for payments, and to declare an emergency.
- " 12-84 To certify special assessments for the repair of the sidewalks where the work was not done by the owner after being ordered by the City in accordance with Ordinance No. 11-48, and it was necessary for the City to do the work and assess the owner.
- " 13-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into an agreement with Clemans, Nelson and Associates, Inc., to provide to the City of Bexley on a priority basis, such employee relations and personnel services as might be required through the duration of this agreement, and to declare an emergency.
- " 14-84 To authorize the City of Bexley to enter into a service contract with Telesystems Corporation for the maintenance of the city's telephone system, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.
- " 15-84 Authorizing the purchase of materials for the maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year 1984, and to declare an emergency.
- " 16-84 To require installation of smoke detectors in certain buildings, and to declare an emergency.

- No. 17-84 An ordinance to amend Amended Ordinance No. 28-80 which had provided for the rezoning of certain property, now known as the Columbia Place property, to a zoning classification of Planned Unit Residential (PUR), and had preliminarily approved a detailed development plan for the property, which included and incorporated certain architectural criteria as part of the overall design concept of the plan, by changing said architectural criteria.
- " 18-84 To appropriate funds. (Administrative personnel training seminar)
- " 19-84 To transfer funds from the unencumbered General Fund to the Bond Retirement Fund and to declare an emergency.
- " 20-84 To appropriate funds for additional Capital Improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1984, to authorize the purchase thereof, and to declare an emergency.
- " 21-84 To appropriate funds. (\$2,500 for preliminary engineering work for the 1984 Street Improvement Project.)
- " 22-84 To appropriate the amount of \$600.00 to pay the cost of a survey for the proposed vacation of the unimproved Front Street right-of-way.
- " 23-84 To repeal Ordinance No. 18-81 and to terminate the existing agreement with the Franklin County Board of Health to provide nursing, social, and rehabilitative services for the residents of the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.
- " 24-84 To authorize the City of Bexley to purchase glass refractors for the City of Bexley streetlighting system, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.
- " 25-84 To authorize the lease, with option to purchase, of a copier for use in the Bexley Police Department, and to declare an emergency.
- " 26-84 To authorize the City of Bexley to enter into a contract with Clemans, Nelson and Associates for a supervisor development program, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.
- " 27-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to sign a Consent and Hold Harmless Agreement on behalf of the City of Bexley with the property owner at 235 South Cassady (Lot No. 9, Amended Plat Bexley Park Extension) regarding improvements to be made upon and within the City owned right-of-way of Elm Avenue.
- " 28-84 To appropriate funds. (Special Police service at Jeffrey Park.)
- " 29-84 To appropriate funds. (Repairs to Bexley Community Pool.)
- " 30-84 DEFEATED - To provide an effective means for protecting the public water system from contamination due to backflow of contaminants through the water service connection into the public water system.
- " 31-84 To authorize various Capital Improvements and the purchase of new equipment for fiscal year 1984, to provide for the transfer and appropriation of the necessary funds.
- " 32-84 NONE.
- " 33-84 To appropriate funds to pay the cost of painting house numbers on the concrete curb at various locations within the City of Bexley.
- " 34-84 To authorize purchase of seven London Plane trees for use by the Bexley Parks Department, and to appropriate funds.
- " 35-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to sign a Consent and Hold Harmless Agreement on behalf of the City of Bexley with the property owner at 63 South Cassady (Lot number 9; Bexley Addition) regarding improvements to be made upon and within the City owned right-of-way of Cassady Avenue.
- " 36-84 To vacate the unimproved Front Street right-of-way lying between Delmar Drive and North Stanwood Avenue.
- " 37-84 To appropriate funds to complete the 1983 Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project.
- " 38-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids for the repair of sidewalks at various locations in the City of Bexley, to appropriate funds.

- No. 39-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with The Justinian Publishing Company for the continual updating of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley.
- " 40-84 To repeal the provisions of Ordinance No. 19-69 passed July 8, 1969 (Chapter 410, Codified Ordinances) regarding the establishment and operation of a Traffic Violations Bureau in the City of Bexley.
- " 41-84 To establish rules and regulations for the installation of underground sprinkler systems by private property owners where such improvements obtrude or encroach upon public property, or upon easements or rights-of-way granted to the City of Bexley for public purposes.
- " 42-84 To appropriate various sums from the unencumbered General Fund for transfer to and adjustment of other accounts.
- " 43-84 To establish the position of Assistant Service Director for the City of Bexley, to establish a salary range, job responsibilities, and qualifications, and to amend Ordinance No. 2-84 accordingly.
- " 44-84 AMENDED - To rezone the property located at 635 Montrose Avenue (part of lot 14, Bexley Plaza Addition) from the Community Commercial (CC) Zoning District to the Medium Density Single Family Residential (R-6) Zoning District and to amend the district boundaries on the Official Zoning Map accordingly.
- " 45-84 Authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to sign a Consent and Hold Harmless Agreement on behalf of the City of Bexley with the Bexley Board of Education regarding improvements to be made upon and within the City owned right-of-ways.
- " 46-84 Authorizing a variance to allow for a 36" high decorative picket fence to remain in the front yard set back area at 2728 Brentwood Road (Lot 115, Bexley Highlands Amd.) premises owned by Seyman L. and Sadie L. Stern.
- " 47-84 To authorize the City of Bexley to enter into an agreement with the legislative authorities of not less than a majority of the other municipal corporations and political subdivisions within Franklin County to provide an Emergency Management Agency to coordinate emergency management activities within the area of Franklin County.
- " 48-84 To appropriate funds. (1985 Police Cruiser, replacement)
- " 49-84 To appropriate additional funds for operating expenses for fiscal year 1984.
- " 50-84 Authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to contract with the Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio, on behalf of the City of Bexley, for a community development block grant program and to provide acquisition services therewith.
- " 51-84 To appropriate additional funds for the 1984 fiscal year.
- " 52-84 To authorize the City Planner to provide planning services regarding additional and expanded recreational facilities for the City of Bexley, to appropriate funds.
- " 53-84 To appropriate funds. (Sign for Mayor's Safety Campaign.)
- " 54-84 To permit David Nichols, formerly the Supervisor of Recreation, to serve as the Interim Director of Recreation, effective as of September 1, 1984, and to establish the salary and privileges for such position.
- " 55-84 To change the title of Superintendent of Water to Manager of Water Department and to amend Ordinance No. 2-84 and all other employment records, rules and regulations accordingly.
- " 56-84 To appropriate additional funds for the 1984 Fiscal Year.
- " 57-84 AMENDED - Approving the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances; providing for the adoption of new matter in the updated and revised Codified Ordinances; Publishing the enactment of such new matter; repealing ordinances in conflict therewith.
- " 58-84 To appropriate various additional sums for the operation of City Hall and for increased costs of employee benefits.



- No. 59-84 To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into an agreement with Mark G. Feinknopf, architect and planner, on behalf of the City of Bexley, to provide planning, design, and architectural consultation and services on a continuing basis regarding the use and development of public grounds and the location, character, and construction of public buildings and other public property, to appropriate funds.
- " 60-84 To appropriate funds to the Mayor's Newsletter Account to pay the costs of the newsletter regarding the completion and early payment of the costs of the construction and installation of the new street light system.
- " 61-84 To appropriate additional funds to pay the costs of updating the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley by the Justinian Publishing Company.
- " 62-84 To increase the salary of the Auditor of the City of Bexley, effective as of the term of office commencing January 1, 1986 and thereafter, to repeal all previous salary ordinances regarding the position of Auditor.
- " 63-84 To make additional appropriations for Fiscal Year 1984 for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Bexley.
