

ORDINANCE NO. 17 83

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 2-83 regarding hours of work, rates of pay and fringe benefits for all city employees, by correcting and clarifying salaries, step-increases, and paid holidays, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2083, adopted by this council on January 25, 1983, establishing wages and working conditions for all employees of the City of Bexley, be amended as follows:

(a) On page 2 at the bottom of the page, under subparagraph "A. Radio Dispatchers:" the salary for civilian radio dispatchers, beginning 2nd year, should be changed from "\$12,947.00" to "\$13,853.00";

(b) On page 3 in the first paragraph at the top of the page, under subparagraph "B. Parking Control Officer", the beginning 2nd year salary should be changed from "\$12,947.00" to "\$13,853.00";

(c) On page 3, again in the first paragraph at the top of the page, but under subparagraph "C. Dog Warden", the beginning 2nd year salary should be changed from "\$12,947.00" to "\$13,853.00";

(d) On page 3, in the first paragraph after Schedule II regarding secretaries, the salary listed for "After 1st year" should be changed from "\$11,800.00" to "\$12,626.00";

(e) On page 4, the first paragraph at the top of the page regarding the schedule of holidays, be deleted in its entirety and the following language, previously adopted by council in Ordinance No. 18-82, be inserted in its place:

All holidays will be based upon Federal holiday standards and will be the same as those observed by the Federal Government on behalf of Federal Employees. Holidays for salaried employees will be: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. In addition, salaried employees shall be entitled to three (3) personal holidays to be taken during the calendar year at the discretion of the employee upon approval by the Department Head. Said personal holidays shall be accrued based on the number of months of continuous municipal service in each calendar year as follows: one personal holiday after one months service; one personal holiday after six months service; and one personal holiday after eight months service. If salaried employees work any sanctioned holidays, excluding personal holidays, they will be compensated in compensatory time off. Any employee absent the working day before or after a holiday, without prior approval, shall not be paid for the holiday.

(f) On page 7, under Schedule IV, the salary of the Law Director shall be changed from thirteen thousand seven hundred dollars (\$13,700.00), to fourteen thousand six hundred sixty dollars (\$14,660.00).

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance

necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
health and safety, and this ordinance shall go into force and
effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
