

ORDINANCE NO. 18-83

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 15-83 and to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to accept bids for the lease of a new telephone system for the City and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 15-83 authorized the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a lease for a new telephone system for the City; and

WHEREAS, said lease was found to be unacceptable in that the language it contained would have violated the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, significant cost can be saved by providing a leased telephone system for the City prior to the completion of the Police Headquarters Alteration Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 15-83 adopted on February 22, 1983 is hereby repealed.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the lease, delivery and installation of a new telephone system for the City.

Section 3: That the Council of the City of Bexley has, by Ordinance No. 1-83, appropriated funds to pay for the present rental, which funds are hereby authorized to be applied to the new lease agreement.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
