

ORDINANCE NO. 19 -83

An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds for the purchase of logging/recorder equipment for use by the Bexley Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 5-83 authorized the Mayor and Auditor to accept bids, after advertisement according to law, for the purchase of logging/recorder equipment for use by the Bexley Police Department and that the amount of \$21,800.00 was appropriated in Ordinance No. 1-83 to pay the cost of same.

Section 2: That one bid was received on February 16, 1983 in the amount of \$22,043.00 and that a contract was awarded by the Board of Control conditioned on the acceptance of City Council by the adoption of an additional appropriation in the total amount of \$243.00.

Section 3: That the amount of \$243.00 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the general fund to pay the additional cost of the equipment.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
