

ORDINANCE NO. 20-83

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to accept Change Order Number 6, on the Bexley Police Headquarters Building Project and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, during the course of construction on the Police Headquarters Building Project it was found that the existing roof structure on the old building was deteriorated through age and in need of replacement, and

WHEREAS, said work was not included on the original specifications and plans, and

WHEREAS, said work has been identified as Items A-1 and A-2 on Change Order Number 6, submitted by the Contractor and approved by the Architect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to accept Change Order Number 6 from the Columbus Contractor Company in the total amount of \$9,989.44.

Section 2: That the sum of \$9,989.44 has already been appropriated in Ordinance No. 1-83 to be used to pay the additional costs under the contract.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
