ORDINANCE NO. 23-83

'An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 18-83 and to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a new telephone system for the City and to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 18-83 authorized the Mayor and Auditor to accept bids for the acquisition, delivery and installation of a new telephone system for the City; and

WHEREAS, bids were received by the City on March 18, 1983 for both the leasing on a five year basis and the purchase of said telephone system; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Bexley Board of Control, after meeting on March 21, 1983, that a contract be awarded to GTE Telsystems Corporation for the purchase of a GTE Electronic Key System which was determined by the Board as the lowest bid that best meets the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of said system will result in the additional savings of \$10,136.00 by eliminating the sixty month financing cost and the twenty percent buyout provision contained in the bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 18-83 should be, and it hereby is, amended by allowing for the purchase of a new telephone system as an alternative to the lease of said system.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a purchase contract with GTE Telsystems Corporation for the purchase of a GTE Electronic Key Telephone System at a bid price of \$24,830.00 which was determined by the Bexley Board of Control as the lowest and best bid on March 21, 1983 for bids received on March 18, 1983.

Section 3. That the amount of \$24,830.00 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered general fund for the total purchase cost of said system.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and its approval by the Mayor.
