

ORDINANCE NO. 27-83

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to accept bids for the purchase of four new Police Cruisers and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase and delivery of four (4) new Police Cruisers, the specifications for which are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That the amount of \$37,200.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the General Fund in Ordinance Number 1-83 for the purchase of said vehicles and that the contract, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that these vehicles are necessary for the proper operation of the Police Department, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
