

ORDINANCE NO. 28-83

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to reimburse a contractor for building permit fees paid to the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That on August 5, 1982, Bexley Building Permit Number 11234 and Zoning Permit Number 797 were issued to the Columbus Contractor Company on behalf of the property owners, Edwin M. & Geraldine R. Ellman, 260 North Columbia Avenue to construct a room addition to the existing house.

Section 2: That the contemplated construction for which the necessary permits were issued was never implemented and no inspections were provided by the Bexley Building Department.

Section 3: That the amount of \$390.00 was collected from the contractor on behalf of the property owner to pay the permit fees and that they should be reimbursed for this expenditure by the City.

Section 4: That the amount of \$390.00 should be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the General Fund and the Auditor is hereby authorized to pay that amount to the Columbus Contractor Company.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
