

ORDINANCE NO. 31-83

An Ordinance to authorize work on the World War II monument at the Drexel Circle.

WHEREAS, the World War II monument at the Drexel Circle was constructed by the American Legion and the Bexley Lions Club and was then dedicated to the City of Bexley; and

WHEREAS, the names of four Bexley residents who served in the United States Armed Forces during World War II were erroneously omitted from the list of names on said monument; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a request from Laurence L. Felsenthal to add the names of Alvin Schottenstein, Jerome Schottenstein, Leon Schottenstein and Saul Schottenstein to the monument.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted to Laurence L. Felsenthal to have the names of Alvin Schottenstein, Jerome Schottenstein, Leon Schottenstein and Saul Schottenstein who were all Bexley residents and veterans of World War II added in the available space on the World War II monument at the Drexel Circle.

Section 2. That said work shall be done by a professional stone-cutter and that the four names be added in the same size and style of lettering as the names already placed on the monument.

Section 3. That said work shall be accomplished at the total cost of the applicant but that the work must be supervised by the Service Director of the City of Bexley.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
