

ORDINANCE NO. 37-83

An ordinance to amend the rules and regulations regarding the use of parks and public grounds within the City of Bexley and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That Ordinance 22-71, which was adopted on July 27, 1971, provided rules and regulations governing the operation and use of the parks and public grounds in the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That said Ordinance, as subsequently amended by Ordinance 42-76, was included within the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley as adopted on December 11, 1979, and became identified as Chapter 1062 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 3. That Section 1062.30 within said Chapter imposes restrictions upon entering any building, enclosure, or place within any of the parks, which has been posted "No Admittance", and provides for a criminal penalty for the violation thereof.

Section 4. That said Section 1062.30, should be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1062.30 ENTERING PROHIBITED AREAS. no person shall enter onto any park and/or recreation facility, nor enter any building, enclosure or place within any of the parks, where or upon which the words, "No Admittance", are displayed or posted by sign, placard or otherwise, without the consent of the Recreation Director or other officer of the parks."

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the community, such emergency being the necessity to have such prohibited areas designated before the opening of the parks, and will become effective immediately upon passage by two-thirds of the elected members to council and approval by the Mayor.
