

ORDINANCE NO. 39-83

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to be used for the Mayor's Court payment to the State Reparations Program, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has mandated that the Bexley Mayor's Court, as well as other courts in the State, assess and collect a surcharge from defendants convicted in said courts, which funds were to be paid into State Reparations Program Fund, and

WHEREAS, the surcharge amount has varied from as little as \$3.00 per case to as much as \$13.00 per case, as different programs were included within the Fund, and now is set a \$9.00 per case, and

WHEREAS, the Bexley Mayor's Court has collected the funds as required by the State of Ohio, had maintained the records necessary for the determination, and has complied in all other respects, with the State law, but has inadvertently paid the funds so collected into the General Fund of the City of Bexley, instead of directly to the State of Reparations Program; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ~~THE~~ CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$8105.00 be, and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the Bexley Mayor's Court Fund, to be used to pay the amounts now due from said Court to the State Reparations Program.

Section 2. That said sum represents the amount previously collected in said Mayor's Court for said Reparations Program which amount had been inadvertently paid into the General Fund of the City.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of said City and shall go into effect upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
