

ORDINANCE NO. 40 83

Our Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into an agreement with the Battelle Memorial Institute to authorize research investigation into polycarbonate street light refractors, to appropriate the sum of \$2,000, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a proposed research program agreement with Battelle Memorial Institute, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein, to provide information on the service life conditions for present and future polycarbonate street light refractors.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,000 be, and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the costs of such research services.

Section 3. That the Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of peace, health and safety of said City and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor.
