

ORDINANCE NO. 41 - 83

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids for the repair of sidewalks at various locations in the City of Bexley and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into contracts with the lowest and best bidder for the replacement of cement concrete sidewalks at various locations in the City.

Section 2. That the amount of \$25,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the Sidewalk Fund in Ordinance Number 1-83 for the above purpose and that the contract, as specified, shall not exceed that amount.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
