

ORDINANCE NO. 44 -83

An ordinance to authorize and direct the Mayor and Auditor to solicit for bids for the purchase and installation of firing range equipment, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, and to appropriate funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$12,000 has been previously appropriated (in Ordinance 2-83) and allocated to Account 1200-2 for the intended purchase and installation of the necessary firing range equipment, which includes shooting booths, lighting, barricades, a target conveying systems, a bullet trap, and the audio and power control;

Section 2. That a survey of the market now indicates that such sum is insufficient and that an additional \$6,000 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and allocated to Account 1200-2 to be used for the purchase and installation of such equipment;

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to solicit for bids, pursuant to law, and to enter into contracts with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase, delivery, and installation of the required firing range equipment the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor and which are incorporated herein by reference;

Section 4. That the total cost of said contract shall not exceed \$18,000 which sum shall be paid by the money appropriated and allocated to Account 1200-2;

Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
