

ORDINANCE NO. 45 -83

An Ordinance to transfer previously appropriated funds for special police to the Recreation Department accounts and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That by Ordinance 2-83 the sum of \$12,000 was appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and allocated to account 180-4 for special police, for the purpose of hiring summer part-time police personnel to be used at the Jeffrey Mansion facility;

Section 2. That a subsequent policy decision has been made to eliminate the special police and to have the functions performed by regular off-duty police officers on special duty to the Recreation Department;

Section 3. For that purpose, the sum of money previously appropriated to Account 180-4 should be, and it is, hereby transferred to the Recreation Department, Series 800 Accounts, to the account established or designated for that purpose by the Auditor's office;

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
