

ORDINANCE NO. 56 -83

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Kustom Quality Electronics of Lenexa, Kansas to purchase a Falcon Radar Unit with Adaptor and Display, to appropriate funds for said purchase, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the effective operation of the Bexley Police Department and the regulation of the flow of vehicular traffic in and through the City of Bexley requires the utilization of traffic safety radar units and that the present hand-held radar unit is no longer serviceable.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor should be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a purchase contract with Kustom Quality Electronics of Lenexa, Kansas for the purchase of a replacement traffic safety radar unit, known as the Falcon Radar Unit with Adaptor and Display for the total price of \$2,295.00.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,095.00 be set aside and appropriated from the Unencumbered General Fund to be applied towards the purchase price and that the present unit be traded-in to the seller for a credit of \$200.00 for the balance of the purchase price.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
