

ORDINANCE NO. 58 -83

An Ordinance to reappropriate the sum of \$4,678.00 for expenses incurred by Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for their work on the Police Department Renovation Project, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 25-81 authorized the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for professional services as architects for the Police Department Renovation Project which provided for a fee of \$27,500.00 for basic services and an unspecified amount for reimburseable expenses.

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 37-82 appropriated the sum of \$5,184.00 for reimburseable expenses incurred by Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for their work on the Police Department Renovation Project.

Section 3: That out of the total appropriation of \$32,684.00, the amount of \$27,637.00 was paid to Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., during fiscal 1982.

Section 4: That the contract is a continuing obligation and must be funded for fiscal 1983 in the full amount due Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., to cover the total cost of all services performed.

Section 5: That the sum of \$4,678.00 is hereby reappropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the total amount due Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for their work on the Police Department Renovation Project.

Section 6: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
