An ordinance to authorize the City of Bexley to enter into a contract with John E. Foster and Associates, Inc., for engineering services in regard to a traffic study of the Clifton Avenue Bridge, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor should be, and they are hereby, authorized to enter into a contract with the engineering firm of John E. Foster and Associates, Inc., to perform a traffic study of the Clifton Avenue Bridge, pursuant to the proposal previously submitted by said engineers, the terms of which are hereby incorporated and made a part of this authorization by reference.

Section 2. That the sum of \$8,455 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the appropriate account, to be used to pay the costs of the contract as those costs are itemized and set forth in the cost proposal.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of said city and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
