

ORDINANCE NO. 62 -83

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$1,835.00 for the purchase of a photocopier machine for the Bexley Recreation Department, to authorize the expenditure and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Bexley Recreation Department purchased an OCE-1260 photocopier machine on February 2, 1978, and said machine is no longer operable and, therefore, does not meet the needs of the Department;

Section 2: That the Director of the Recreation Department received three quotations for the purchase of a new photocopier machine and the quotation submitted by the John Goetz Company for a Sharp SF-755 copier was the lowest and best quotation for a total price of \$1,835.00, which includes a discount for the trade-in of the OCE-1260 machine;

Section 3: That it is necessary to meet the requirements of the Recreation Department's present and future needs to upgrade the equipment to provide greater and more economical copying capacity;

Section 4: That, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a purchase contract with the John Goetz Company for a Sharp SF-755 photocopier machine, for a total price of \$1,835.00;

Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
