An ordinance to appropriate funds to pay for audit fees, for services already performed, but not covered by Ordinance No. 16-83, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council, by the provisions of Ordinance No. 16-83 authorized the Auditor of the City of Bexley, upon permission of the Chief Inspector and Supervisor of Public Offices, to engage the professional services of an independent accountant to conduct the biannual inspection and supervision of public offices for the City of Bexley;

Section 2. That, by the same ordinance, this Council appropriated the sum of \$5,000.00 to pay the cost of such professional services, which sum has now been expended;

Section 3. That the independent accountant, in its original cost estimates had not included the cost of auditing the Mayor's Court funds which covered the activities of the Court over a 21 month period at a cost of \$1,250.00 in addition to the monies paid;

Section 4. That the sum of \$1,250.00 should be, and it is, hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the Auditor's Audit Fees Account to be used to pay the costs of these additional services;

Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
