An ordinance to authorize the City Solicitor to render service to the City of Bexley in litigation in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas and to appropriate funds.

WHEREAS, The salary of the City Solicitor, is established by Council on an annual basis and is compensation for all services rendered as attorney and counsel for the City and for all officers and departments thereof in matters relating to their official duties; and

WHEREAS, Such salary and compensation do not cover services performed in any litigated matters wherein the City or any official thereof is involved and the compensation for such services shall be as may be agreed upon by such Solicitor and Council, (see Section 234.03, Bexley Code); and

WHEREAS, The City Solicitor has represented the City of Bexley in the case of CMS Industries vs. City of Bexley Case no. 83CV-03-1630, Franklin County Court of Common Pleas which case has now been dismissed with prejudice and terminated and has expended a total of 13-1/4 hours of legal time; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to represent the City of Bexley in such litigation and that he be compensated at the rate of \$60.00 per hour for his services in representing the City of Bexley in this litigation which amounts to a total fee of \$795.00 for the time expended.

Section 2. That the sum of \$795.00 be, and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the appropriate account in order to compensate the City Solicitor for such services.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
