An ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$2,500.00 for the purchase of three (3) typewriters for use in the Police Department and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the typewriters presently in use in the Bexley Police Department were acquired as used equipment from other departments of the City and are not now adequate for their intended use and cannot be economically repaired;

Section 2. That new and additional equipment should be acquired for use in the Police Department, consisting of at least three (3) new typewriters, and for that purpose the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the appropriate Police Department account for the purchase of the same;

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
