A Resolution by the Council authorizing the Auditor of the City of Bexley to request that the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio remove the 2.65 mill street light construction levy from the tax duplicate of the residents of the City of Bexley effective immediately.

WHEREAS, At the request of this Council, the citizens of the City of Bexley have approved a 3 mill levy to raise funds for the payment of the costs of the construction and installation of a new street light system in the City of Bexley; and

WHEREAS, That system has now been completed for some few years and the tax levy has been imposed on the tax duplicates of the residents of the City of Bexley and collected from their tax payments; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bexley has now accumulated sufficient sums in the Capital Improvements Fund to pay off the balance of \$1,150,000.00 of the street light construction notes and does so intend to pay such notes when they become due at the end of October 1984; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor of the City of Bexley, Ohio should be and he is hereby authorized to request from the Treasurer, Franklin County, Ohio, that the 3 mill levy pertaining to street light construction notes (effective 2.65 mill levy) be removed from the tax duplicates of the residents of the City of Bexley effective immediately.
