An ordinance to authorized the City of Bexley to enter into a service contract with Telesystems Corporation for the maintenance of the city's telephone systems, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor should be, and they are, hereby authorized to enter into a service contract with Telesystems Corporation of Worthington, Ohio (an authorized distributor for GTE) to provide maintenance and service for the telephone system in City Hall and the Police Station for the period of one year beginning April 29, 1984;

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,240.25 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered general fund and transferred to the appropriate account in the Auditor's office to pay the cost of the service contract as those payments become due;

Section 3. That the Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety, and shall to into effect upon its adoption and its approval by the Mayor.
