

ORDINANCE NO. 23-84

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 18-81 and to terminate the existing agreement with the Franklin County Board of Health to provide nursing, social and rehabilitative services for residents of the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Bexley Board of Health has recommended that the existing agreement with the Franklin County Board of Health to provide nursing, social and rehabilitative services for residents of the City of Bexley, be terminated; and

WHEREAS, it was a further recommendation of the Bexley Board of Health that the City of Bexley, Ohio, allow referrals for home nursing care to be made to either the Franklin County Board of Health, City of Columbus Board of Health, or to the various available proprietary nursing services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 18-81 be, and it is hereby, repealed, and that the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed to terminate the existing agreement for home health care services with the Franklin County Board of Health.

Section 2. That the Bexley Board of Health be, and it is hereby, authorized to allow referrals for home nursing care to be made to either the Franklin County Board of Health, City of Columbus Board of Health or to the various available proprietary nursing services, provided, however, that nothing in this authorization shall obligate the City of Bexley to pay the cost for said nursing services.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
