

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 24-84

An ordinance to authorize the City of Bexley to purchase glass refractors for the City of Bexley streetlighting system, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor, on behalf of the City of Bexley, be and they hereby are, authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase and delivery of replacement glass refractors for all of the lamps in the City of Bexley streetlighting system, the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor;

Section 2. That the sum of \$25,000.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to be used to pay the costs of the purchase contract, and that the contract, as specified in Section 1 shall not exceed this amount;

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present refractors have become discolored and do not provide adequate or safe lighting, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
