

ORDINANCE NO. 26 -84

An ordinance to authorize the City of Bexley to enter into a contract with Clemans, Nelson and Associates for a supervisor development program, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor, on behalf of the City of Bexley, should be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Clemans, Nelson and Associates for a supervisor development program to be conducted at various dates in May and June, 1984, for all City of Bexley supervisory personnel;

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,500.00 should be, and it is, hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and used to pay the cost of the services of Clemans, Nelson and Associates pursuant to said contract; and

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety; therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its adoption and its approval by the Mayor.
